ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE ON PETITION FOR RECIPROCAL DISCIPLINE AND HEARING SETTING

Pursuant to Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure ("TRDP") Part IX, the Chief Disciplinary Counsel of the State Bar of Texas filed a Petition for Reciprocal Discipline against Respondent William A. Cohn on June 9, 2020. The Petition states that on or about October 22, 2019, the Supreme Court of Tennessee at Nashville entered an Order of Enforcement, ordering public censure of Respondent, in File No. M2019-01855-BARBP, BOPR No. 2018-2875-9-AJ, *In Re: William Allan Cohn, BPR #005873, An Attorney Licensed to Practice Law in Tennessee (Shelby County.* A true and correct copy of the Petition for Reciprocal Discipline, which includes the Order, is attached hereto and incorporated herein in its entirety for all purposes as if set forth in full.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED** that, Respondent, William A. Cohn, shall, within thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Order to Show Cause and Petition for Reciprocal Discipline, show cause why the imposition of identical discipline in Texas by the Board of Disciplinary Appeals pursuant to TRDP § 9.02 would be unwarranted.
