ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL FOR WANT OF JURISDICTION

On this day came on to be heard the Board of Disciplinary Appeals' own motion to dismiss the above appeal filed by Pascual Madrigal for want of jurisdiction. After reviewing the papers filed in the matter, the Board finds that the Appellant filed the notice of appeal of the judgment of active suspension in Cause nos. 201700545, 201703331, and 201704312 on September 25, 2018. On March 15, 2019 Appellant was disbarred by the Evidentiary Panel 10-4 of the District 10 Grievance Committee of the State Bar of Texas in case nos. 201703589 and 201704251. He did not appeal the disbarment. The disbarment is final and the Board of Disciplinary Appeals no longer has jurisdiction over this appeal.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this appeal is hereby DISMISSED for want of jurisdiction with prejudice to refile.
