ANSWER TO FIRST AMENDED PETITION FOR RECIPROCAL DISCIPLINE

NOW IN PROPER PERSON, comes Charles M. Bradshaw, II, who in answer to FIRST AMENDED PETITION FOR RECIPROCAL DISCIPLINE hereby enters a GENERAL DENIAL to every allegation of fact contained the FIRST AMENDED PETITION.

Respondent further pleads that the Commission for Lawyer Discipline is ESTOPPED from seeking reciprocal discipline in that the conduct for which Respondent was disciplined for by the State of Louisiana, a misdemeanor DWI arrest and subsequent dismissal, in no way relates to his practice of law. That the misconduct for which the attorney was disciplined in the other jurisdiction does not constitute Professional Misconduct in Texas. Texas limits' criminal acts which result in misconduct to "as serious crime or.....any other criminal act that reflects adversely on a lawyer's honesty, trustworthiness or fitness as a lawyer in other respects." See, In the Matter of Sean Patrick Mount, Cause 66334; In the Matter of Carl B Duke, Cause 65570.

WHEREFORE RESPONDENT PRAYS that his answer be deemed good and sufficient, and that after all proceedings are had, there be judgment in his favor rejecting the demands for Reciprocal Discipline and dismissing the same at their costs.
