JUDGMENT AFFIRMING JUDGMENT OF PARTIALLY PROBATED SUSPENSION

On April 9 2010, the Board of Disciplinary Appeals heard argument in the appeal by Cyril Chukwurah from the Judgment of Partially Probated Suspension signed June 29, 2009 by the 4B04 Evidentiary Panel of the State Bar of Texas District 4B grievance committee in Cause Nos. H0020723857 and H0120827940. Appellant Chukwurah does not appeal the findings of misconduct, terms of probation, restitution, attorney's fees, expenses, or the 30-day active suspension, to which he agreed. He appeals only the portion of the sanction concerning the length of probation to follow the active suspension.
