ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S SECOND MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

On this day, the Board of Disciplinary Appeals considered the Motion for Continuance filed by the Respondent, Wesley Lindon Clarke, in the above-captioned reciprocal discipline case. Respondent seeks a second continuance and requests that the hearing currently set before the Board on January 28, 2022 be reset. The Petitioner, the Commission for Lawyer Discipline, does not oppose Respondent's motion.

Respondent is currently not eligible to practice law in Texas due to his election to claim an exemption from MCLE requirements. The Board **GRANTS** Respondent's request for a continuance and **ORDERS** the case will be reset for hearing on the earlier of: (1) Friday, April 29, 2022 at 9:00 a.m., or (2) within fourteen (14) days after Respondent becomes eligible to practice law in Texas. The Board further **ORDERS** Respondent to notify the Board immediately if he takes any affirmative action to become eligible to practice law in Texas; the Board will then set the petition for reciprocal discipline for expedited hearing to be held within fourteen (14) days.

Further continuance requests from Respondent shall be disfavored.
