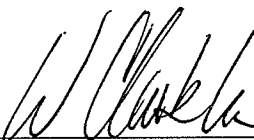
ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL FOR WANT OF PROSECUTION

On this day came on to be heard the Board of Disciplinary Appeals' own motion to dismiss the above appeal filed by Elene B. Glassman for want of prosecution. After reviewing the papers filed in the matter, the Board finds that the Appellant filed her appeal on March 3, 2009. The clerk's record and the reporter's record from the evidentiary hearing were due to be filed on or before April 3, 2009. The CDC filed the clerk's record with the Board on March 26, 2009. The reporter's record was filed May 27, 2009. An order for an extension of time to file the brief signed on July 6, 2009 and the brief was due on July 27, 2009. The Appellant's brief has not been filed, and Appellant has not requested an extension of time to file her brief.

An Order Show Cause was issued on August 25, 2009 giving the Appellant thirty (30) days to show cause why the appeal should not be dismissed for want of prosecution. The Appellant did not respond.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this appeal is hereby **DISMISSED** for want of prosecution with prejudice to refile.
