ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On November 12, 2024, the Board of Disciplinary Appeals considered the Unopposed Motion to Dismiss Appeal filed by Alex R. Hernandez, Jr., Appellant, in the above-captioned appeal from a Judgment of Active Suspension issued June 12, 2024, by Evidentiary Panel 1 of the District 11 Grievance Committee.
