## ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO REMAND FOR RENDITION OF AN AGREED JUDGMENT

On this day, the Board of Disciplinary Appeals considered the Joint Motion to Remand for Rendition of an Agreed Judgment submitted by Appellant Hugh M. Hodges, Jr. and Appellee Commission for Lawyer Discipline in this appeal from an evidentiary judgment signed April 11, 2013, SBOT Case No. D002124955. The parties indicate that they have entered into a settlement agreement and new judgment that will dispose of the action in all respects as documented by the Agreed Judgment of Partially Probated Suspension submitted with the motion.

Therefore, the Board **REVERSES** the Judgment of Active Suspension signed April 11, 2013 in all respects without regard to the merits.

The Board further **REMANDS** the case to the Evidentiary Panel 6-2 of the District 6 Grievance Committee of the State Bar of Texas and **ORDERS** that the evidentiary panel render judgment in accordance with the parties' agreement.

All relief not expressly granted is **DENIED**.
