**ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL**

On this day came on to be heard the Appellant, Rosalind A. Kelly's First Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File Appellant's Brief and Unopposed Motion to Withdraw and/or Dismiss Appeal. After reviewing the papers filed in the matter, the Board finds that the Appellant filed the notice of appeal on December 7, 2017. The clerk's record and the reporter's record from the evidentiary hearing were due to be filed on or before January 18, 2018. The Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel of the State Bar of Texas ("CDC") filed the clerk's record with the Board on January 12, 2018. The Appellant moved for an extension of time to file the reporter's record and it was granted. The reporter's record was due on February 26, 2018 and was filed on March 6, 2018. According to the Order Granting Appellant's Motion to Extend Time to File Reporter's Record, Appellant's brief was due on or before March 25, 2018. However, in correspondence acknowledging receipt of the reporter's record, the parties were mistakenly informed that the Appellant's brief was due April 5, 2018. The Appellant's brief was not filed.

An Order to Show Cause was issued on April 17, 2018 giving the Appellant thirty (30) days to show cause why the appeal should not be dismissed for want of prosecution. The Appellant responded and requested an extension of time to file her brief but stated that she was not intending to file a brief and requested that the appeal be dismissed.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that this appeal is hereby **DISMISSED** with prejudice to refile.
