MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF SHOW CAUSE HEARING

COMES NOW, the Respondent Christopher R. Kelly, and hereby requests a continuance of not less than sixty (60) days of the "Show Cause" hearing currently set for October 25, 2024. In support of this Motion, the Respondent states and informs the Court as follows:

- 1. Respondent is attempting to secure legal counsel which is proving difficult given the nature of this hearing. Sixty (60) days should be sufficient time for Respondent to secure an attorney and allow the attorney enough time to prepare for any Hearing. Respondent also hopes this additional time might allow for a settlement of this matter in lieu of a Hearing.
- 2. Respondent was not disciplined by the Oklahoma Bar Association as he voluntarily resigned his Oklahoma license while one Grievance was pending. He was not disbarred or otherwise disciplined by the Oklahoma Bar Association, and he resigned because he could not afford the cost of defending the Grievance.
- 3. Respondent presently is not a practicing attorney in the State of Texas as evidenced by the Blake Hawthorne filing with this Court by the Office of Disciplinary Counsel.

WHEREFORE, Respondent respectfully requests this Motion be granted.
