JUDGMENT OF NO DISCIPLINE

On the 28th day of January 2011, the above-styled and numbered Petition for Reciprocal Discipline was called for hearing before the Board of Disciplinary Appeals. Petitioner Commission for Lawyer Discipline of the State Bar of Texas appeared by attorney and announced ready. Respondent, Stephen E. Langsdorf, having answered and having been duly notified of the hearing, failed to appear. All issues of fact as well as all questions of law were submitted to the Board of Disciplinary Appeals for determination. Having considered the pleadings on file, having received evidence, and having heard the argument of counsel, the Board of Disciplinary Appeals makes the following findings, conclusions, and orders:

Findings of Fact. The Board of Disciplinary Appeals finds that:

- (1) Respondent, Stephen E. Langsdorf, Bar Card No. is 11922700, is an attorney who licensed but not currently authorized to practice law in the State of Texas due to administrative suspension for failure to pay bar dues and occupational tax.
- (2) On or about March 18, 2009, a Disciplinary Petition was filed with the State of Maine Board of Overseers of the Bar in a matter styled: *Board of Overseers of the Bar v. Stephen E. Langsdorf, Esq. of Augusta, ME, Me. Bar #3500 Respondent*, Grievance Commission Case GCF #08-007.

- (3) On or about April 2, 2009, Respondent filed his Response to Disciplinary Petition with the State of Maine Board of Overseers of the Bar in Grievance Commission Case GCF #08-007.
- (4) On or about June 29, 2009, Respondent signed a Stipulated Report of Findings and Order of Panel D of the Grievance Commission which was entered with the State of Maine Board of Overseers of the Bar in *Board of Overseers of the Bar Petitioner v. Stephen E. Langsdorf, Esq. of Augusta, Maine Me. Bar #3500 Respondent*, GCF #08-007, imposing a Public Reprimand.
- (5) Respondent, Stephen E. Langsdorf, is the same person as the Stephen E. Langsdorf, who is the subject of the Stipulated Report of Findings and Order of Panel D of the Grievance Commission entered with the State of Maine Board of Overseers of the Bar.
- (6) The Stipulated Report of Findings and Order of Panel D of the Grievance Commission entered with the State of Maine Board of Overseers is final.


Conclusions of Law. Based upon the foregoing findings of facts the Board of Disciplinary

Appeals makes the following conclusions of law:

- (1) This Board has jurisdiction to hear and determine this matter. Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure 7.08(H) ("TRDP");
- (2) Having reviewed the record of the disciplinary proceedings in Maine, the Board has determined that the conduct for which Respondent was disciplined in Maine does not constitute Professional Misconduct in this state.
- (3) No discipline is warranted in this case.

It is, accordingly, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that no discipline be imposed.
