DISMISSAL ORDER

On this day came to be heard the Board of Disciplinary Appeals' own motion to dismiss the above-captioned appeal for want of prosecution. After reviewing the papers filed in this matter, the Board finds that Appellant Rodney E. Moton filed his notice of appeal on October 18, 2023. On February 15, 2024, the Board issued a letter to the parties requesting the Appellant file the Reporter's Record within 30 days. Appellant did not respond. On March 27, 2024 the Board issued an Order to Show Cause requesting Appellant to respond and show cause within 30 days why the appeal should not be dismissed for want of prosecution. *See* BODA Internal Procedural Rule 4.03(a), 4.05(f), 4.09. Appellant failed to file a response to the Board's March 27, 2024 order to show cause.

In accordance with Internal Procedural Rules 4.05(f)(1) and 4.09(a) of the Board of Disciplinary Appeals, and on its own motion, the Board **ORDERS** that this appeal is hereby **DISMISSED** for want of prosecution, with prejudice to refiling.
