ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Appellant Dominique Ross Nwajei filed a notice of appeal on April 23, 2024. The clerk of the District 4-2 Grievance Committee of the State Bar of Texas filed the clerk's record on June 5, 2024. In accordance with BODA's Internal Procedural Rule 4.03(a), the reporter's record was due to be filed on June 10, 2024.

On June 18, 2024, the Board sent Appellant a letter stating that the reporter's record was late and requested that Appellant that the reporter's record be filed within thirty (30) days. The letter notified Appellant that failure to file the reporter's record on time may result in the Board dismissing the appeal.

Having received no reporter's record and no request for an extension of time to file the reporter's record, the Board **ORDERS** that Appellant Dominique Ross Nwajei, within thirty (30) days from the date of this order, **RESPOND AND SHOW CAUSE** why the appeal should not be dismissed for want of prosecution. *See* BODA Internal Procedural Rules 4.03(a), 4.09.
