## ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL FOR WANT OF PROSECUTION

On March 10, 2014 came on to be heard the Board of Disciplinary Appeals' own motion to dismiss the appeal filed by Alberto Posada for want of prosecution. After reviewing the papers filed in the matter, the Board finds that the Appellant filed the notice of appeal of the judgment of probated suspension signed on October 31, 2013 by the District 7 grievance committee through evidentiary panel 7-4 in case no. D0031142509 on November 27, 2013. The clerk's record and the reporter's record from the evidentiary hearing were due to be filed on or before December 27, 2013. The Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel of the State Bar of Texas ("CDC") filed the clerk's record on December 18, 2013. On December 23, 2013, the Appellant filed a motion for extension of time to file the reporter's record. The motion was granted and the reporter's record was due January 27, 2014. The reporter's record was filed on January 7, 2014. The appellant's brief was due on or before February 27, 2014 and it has not been filed, and Appellant has not requested an extension of time to file his brief.

On March 12, 2014 this Board issued its Corrected Order to Show Cause wherein the Appellant was ordered to respond and show cause as to why the cause should not be dismissed for want of prosecution. Appellant did not respond or file a brief or request an extension of time to do so.
