## ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Appellant Roy Lee Reeves filed a notice of appeal on December 28, 2022. The clerk of the District 1 Grievance Committee of the State Bar of Texas filed the clerk's record on March 18, 2022. As communicated to the parties multiple times, the reporter's record was due to be filed on March 17, 2022.

On May 19, 2022, the Board sent Appellant an email stating that the reporter's record was late, requesting that the reporter's record be filed within thirty (30) days, and notifying Appellant that failure to file the reporter's record on time may result in the Board dismissing the appeal.

On June 21, 2022, the Board sent Appellant a letter stating that the reporter's record was late and again requesting that Appellant ensure that it be filed within thirty (30) days. The letter again notified Appellant that failure to file the reporter's record on time may result in the Board dismissing the appeal.

Having received no reporter's record and no request for an extension of time to file the reporter's record, the Board **ORDERS** that Appellant Roy Lee Reeves shall, within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of this order, **RESPOND AND SHOW CAUSE** why the appeal should not be dismissed for want of prosecution. *See* BODA Internal Procedural Rule 4.03(a), 4.09.
