ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE BRIEF AND DISMISSING APPEAL FOR WANT OF PROSECUTION

On this day the Board of Disciplinary Appeals considered the Appellant's Motion to Extend Time for Filing Appellant's Brief (email sent on July 7, 2015 at 4:56 p.m.) filed by William V. Wade in this appeal from a Judgment of Partially Probated Suspension signed July 23, 2014. The Appellee, Commission for Lawyer Discipline, did not respond. Appellant filed the reporter's record April 22, 2015. The Board granted an extension to file the Appellant's brief on June 3, 2015 and his brief was due on June 29, 2015. On June 29, 2015, Appellant requested a second extension of time to file the brief. The motion was granted and the Appellant was given until July7, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. to file his brief. The order specifically stated that if the brief was not timely filed the appeal would be dismissed for want of prosecution with no further notice to the parties. Appellant is currently actively suspended from practicing law.

Therefore, the Board **DENIES** the motion for an extension of time to file his brief and this appeal is hereby **DISMISSED** for want of prosecution with prejudice to refile.
