ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL WITHOUT PREJUDICE

On this day, came on to be considered the Motion for Non-Suit filed by Petitioner Commission for Lawyer Discipline of the State Bar of Texas which is accepted as a Motion for Dismissal Without Prejudice. The Board of Disciplinary Appeals signed an Order of Interlocutory Suspension against Respondent in this matter on October 8, 2008, suspending Respondent's license to practice law in Texas until further order. On August 18, 2009, this Board disbarred Respondent in a separate case, *In re Sumrow* (BODA Case 42036), and that judgment is now final. The Board finds, therefore, that this matter is moot and that the Motion for Dismissal Without Prejudice should be granted.

It is therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Petitioner's Motion for Dismissal Without Prejudice is granted, and that the Petition for Compulsory Discipline be, and is hereby, DISMISSED without prejudice to the refilling of the same.

It is further, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that all Orders entered in Cause No. 42678 are hereby rendered no longer in force and effect.
